Govt approves Nokia, Samsung, and 40 others under the PLI scheme

New Delhi: The communications ministry granted approval to 42 companies including Nokia, Samsung, Ericsson's partner Jabil, Flextronics, Tejas Networks, VVDN, and HFCL, under the production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme for telecom and networking products. The companies have committed investments of ₹4115 crores. Out of the total approved, 17 companies have applied for an additional incentive of 1% under design-led manufacturing criteria.

Airtel to upskill staff as the 5G era begins

"Nearly 20,000 professionals in the Airtel Ecosystem have been trained in the basics of IP technology in preparation for the 5G rollout," Amrita Padda, Chief People Officer, Bharti Airtel, told ET.

5G to enable IPR, and create jobs locally: Telecom secretary

"We should use 5G as the opportunity to create local jobs and intellectual property rights (IPR), " secretary, of the Department of Telecommunications (DoT) K Rajaraman said. The official further said that the Telecom Technology Development Fund (TTDF) is another initiative aimed to develop technologies and manufacturing locally, and that would help in the creation of jobs through skill development.



5G rollout to be faster in India, gears from neighboring countries need more checks:

Nokia India Head of Marketing and Corporate Affairs, Amit Marwah, without naming China expressed concern over 'infiltration equipment' in the telecom sector from neighbouring countries. "We (India) are not late, we are at the right time. In the rest of the country compared to other countries where the ecosystem has to develop. We have a 5G-ready ecosystem. We have 10 percent of smartphones in India that are 5G ready. India is going to witness the fastest rollout of 5G which will be at least three times faster than what we have seen in 4G," Marwah said.
